Applicants must have KCSE Mean Grade C with credits in relevant Chemistry (for Soil Chemistry) and Physics (Soil Physics); (those who were employed by the University before 2007 will be considered with the KCSE/KCE grades they already have) plus a Diploma in any one of the following areas; Chemistry; Science Laboratory Technology or Earth Sciences or Soil and Water Engineering from a recognized learning Institution. They should have three (3) years' experience as Trainee Technologist grade IV.

The successful candidate will be expected to participate in organization running of soil chemistry and related practicals for students. This in addition to routine soil water and plant tissues analysis and maintaining laboratory equipment (for Technologist Soil Chemistry); prepare teaching/research materials for students, Lecturers/Researchers for smooth running of practicals field classes in addition to laboratory, field and greenhouse duties (for Technologist; Soil Physics).
